

## **The Mamoli series: key style features for the four Spa Design projects**

**The Stilo, Pico, Euclide and Fuente series by Mamoli will be those chosen by the designers for the event devoted to home wellness scheduled as part of the Fuorisalone 2009**

Devised to open up a window onto the major contemporary design trends applied to the variegated world of wellness, the Spa Design exhibition provides new impulse for research into an unprecedented concept for home wellness. Held as one of the Fuorisalone 2009 events, in the “Temporary Museum for New Design” at Superstudio 13, this show organised by My Exhibition will propose four thematic projects created by prestigious architects: Alberto Apostoli, Franco Scaglia, Mauro Biagi and Yoshie Otomi (Spa Plan), and Silvia Giannini. The four very different concepts will reveal home wellness trends, using new languages, original design solutions and experiments with materials: Alberto Apostoli with “Home SPA - La Casa Benessere”, Mauro Biagi and Yoshie Otomi of Spa Plan with “Eco Suite SPA - La Suite SPA ecosostenibile ad impatto zero”, Silvia Giannini with “Glamour SPA - Uno spazio benessere privato al femminile”, and Franco Scaglia with “Il Bagno Benessere SPA - Lugar de Relax Maximo”. As the prestigious partner in the show, Mamoli confirms its central role in the evolution of contemporary design applied to wellness areas with its presence. All four projects, in fact, will feature Mamoli’s tap and shower series: Stilos, for Silvia Giannini, Fuente and Euclide for Spa Plan, Pico for Alberto Apostoli and Fuente again for Franco Scaglia. Series that will be key style features for the four projects, features marked by a choice favouring quality design, and confirming the versatility of the extensive Mamoli catalogue, which offers solutions suited to the most widely differing styles.
